

OTRM High-need LEAs/Schools for 2005

(166 schools; updated 6/10/05)

Districts must first qualify with 20%+ school aged children in poverty according to U.S. Census figures and 3.5% or more teachers with provisional licenses (TSPC data). After that, individual schools in eligible districts qualify with 40%+ children eligible for free or reduced lunches (Oregon Department of Education data).
